An expedited pathway is now available for current Medical Radiation Practitioners and Sonographers in Australia and New Zealand! You are eligible for the expedited licensure pathway if you are:

- Licensed in good standing with the Medical Radiation Practice Board as a radiation therapist, nuclear medicine technologist, MRI technologist, radiological technologist, or sonographer (New Zealand Only).
- Licensed in good standing with the Australian Sonography Accreditation Registry
