WHY WORK AS A MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGIST IN NOVA SCOTIA

Medical Laboratory Technology professionals in Nova Scotia are tasked with a variety of responsibilities within their scope of practice including assisting in the diagnosis of illness or disease, performing blood, urine and tissue specimen tests, operating lab equipment, and analysing test results. Those wishing for a career with the Laboratory Sciences can train and find employment as Medical Laboratory Assistants (MLA), Medical Laboratory Technicians, or Medical Laboratory Technologists. The profession benefits from many growth and professional development opportunities.

Nova Scotia offers a first-of-its-kind in Canada license requirement for medical lab assistants, governed by the Nova Scotia College of Medical Laboratory Technologists (NSCMLT) and supported by the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science (CSMLS). This license recognizes the important work of the MLA profession, and ensures that personnel are practicing safely, competently, and ethically. MLT professionals in Nova Scotia are entitled to entry with the CSMLS, which offers networking and learning opportunities via conferences and online forums.

PATHWAY FOR LICENSURE FOR MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGISTS

If you are an internationally educated medical laboratory technologist who wants to practice in Nova Scotia, there are three important steps:

- You need to complete a prior learning assessment (PLA) through the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Sciences (CSMLS) and successfully pass the national certification exam.
- You must register with the Nova Scotia College of Medical Laboratory Technologists (NSCMLT) to be licensed.
